Financial Assistance for School Expenses Application

1 What is the Assistance for School Expenses?

This program is designed to help those parents with children enrolled in Toyota city elementary and junior high schools who are having difficulty sending their children to school for financial reasons. It is intended to assist with school supply expenses, school lunch fee, etc. so that all children can attend school without worries.

2 Eligibility

- (1) Family receiving Public Assistance [SEIKATSU HOGO]
- (2) Family that had the Public Assistance benefit cancelled or annulled
- (3) Those who are in financial trouble (total income of all family members living together is within the standard set by Toyota City)

3 Income guidelines

- * The income guideline will be revised according to changes in the standard amount of public assistance.
- * The amount of income that can be certified will vary depending on assets, family situation, etc.

4 Submission of Application Form

If you wish to apply, fill out the attached "Financial Assistance for School Expenses Application" and submit it along with the necessary documents to the school (for each elementary and junior high school) where your child attends.

- If you have been certified to receive the financial assistance, you are eligible for exemption of After School Program participation fee. For further information, contact the Child and Youth Policy Division.

6 Payment

Payment will be made by bank transfer to the account of the applicant. However, under special circumstances, payment will be made in cash.

7 Other

If the application form alone is not enough to certify the financial assistance, an investigation of the family situation by the local welfare commissioner will be required.

Please be advised that in case you get qualified to receive the financial assistance, your information will be shared with the local welfare commissioner. They will also make a home visit to you.

What are local welfare commissioners [Minsei Iin/Jido iin]?

Commissioned by the Minister of Health, Labor and Welfare and they work from the standpoint of local residents.

They look after the children in the community and provide consultation and support for concerns about child rearing so that the children in the community can live in good health and peace of mind.
