

Safety Guidelines for Bicycles

Do you know the correct position where cyclists should ride?

When there is no walkway




left side.

※Exceptionally, bicycles are permitted on walkways but they should run slowly as well give priority to the pedestrians.

When there are bicycle lanes



Cyclists should run on the bicycle lane.



※For your safety, do not run on opposite direction.

There are restrictions to ride a bicycle on walkways.

On streets and avenues where there are roadway and walkway demarcation, bicycles should be conducted on the left side of roadways. However, cyclists may road on walkways running close to the roadway in the following situations.



There are traffic signs allowing bicycles to ride on sidewalks.

Cyclist is under 13 years old, over 70 or physically disabled who cannot ride in safet yon the roadway.

In order to ensure safety conditions it is unavoidable to ride on walkway.

Main violations regarding to bicycle traffic

Penalty up to 50,000 yen

Imprisonment of up to 3 months or penalty up to 50,000 yen.
















Penalty up to 20,000 yen









Do you know the correct way to turn right or left at intersections?







There are traffic lights for pedestrians cyclists and crossing lanes for bicycles
