Notice regarding your National Health Insurance Eligibility Notification

Enclosed is your new National Health Insurance (NHI) Eligibility Notification [*Shikaku Joho no Oshirase*] (hereinafter referred to as the "Eligibility Notification"). This notification has been issued to NHI members who, as of May 31, 2026, **had already registered their My Number Card for use as a health insurance card** (Myna Health Insurance Card). Please continue to present your Myna Health Insurance Card when receiving medical services at medical institutions, pharmacies, and other healthcare providers.

Please dispose of your current Eligibility Notification **on or after August 1, 2026**, ensuring that any personal information is properly protected.

Request

- ① Please keep your Eligibility Notification with your Myna Health Insurance Card.

If your Myna Health Insurance Card cannot be read by a card reader at a medical institution due to a system malfunction or other technical issue, please **present both your Myna Health Insurance Card and your Eligibility Notification** at the reception desk. The Eligibility Notification serves as proof of your insurance coverage and can be used to verify your eligibility information.

- ② If you have enrolled in another health insurance plan, such as Employees' Health Insurance [*Shakai hoken*], please **complete the procedure to withdraw from NHI.**

You may submit your withdrawal application using one of the following methods:

- ・ Online (electronic application)
- ・ By mail
- ・ In person at the division in charge

※ To apply online, please scan the QR code shown on the right.

※ This notice has been sent to individuals who were enrolled in NHI as of **June 18, 2026**.

- ③ Please ensure that your NHI tax is paid by the due date.

If your NHI tax remains unpaid without a valid reason, you may be required, after prior notice, to pay the full cost of medical treatment at the time of service. If you are experiencing difficulty making payments, please contact the **Debt Collection Division** [*Saiken Kanri-ka*] in advance to discuss your situation and available payment arrangements.



«Additional information»

- ① An expiration date is indicated on the Eligibility Notification for individuals who will reach age **75 by July 31, 2027**, and for foreign nationals.

- ② Renewal notices for the **Certificate of Application of Maximum Copayment Amount** [*Gendogaku Tekiyo Ninteisho*] will no longer be sent.

When using a Myna Health Insurance Card, information regarding your maximum copayment limit is automatically linked to your health insurance records. Therefore, carrying a Certificate of Application of Maximum Copayment Amount and completing renewal procedures will no longer be necessary.
