Notice regarding your National Health Insurance Eligibility Certificate

Enclosed is your new **National Health Insurance Eligibility Certificate** [*Shikaku Kakuninsho*] (hereinafter referred to as "Eligibility Certificate"), which is valid through **July 31, 2027**. This certificate is being issued to National Health Insurance (NHI) members who, as of May 31, 2026, have not registered their My Number Card for use as a health insurance card (Myna Health Insurance Card).

Please securely dispose of your current Eligibility Certificate on or after August 1, 2026, taking appropriate measures to protect your personal information.

Request

- ① Please consider using a Myna Health Insurance Card (Please also see the reverse side for details.)
With a **Myna Health Insurance Card**, your maximum copayment limit information is automatically linked to your health insurance data. This eliminates the need to carry a **Certificate of Application of Maximum Copayment Amount** [*Gendogaku Tekiyo Ninteisho*] and removes the need for renewal procedures.
- ② If you have enrolled in another health insurance plan, such as **Employees' Health Insurance [Shakai hoken]**, please complete the procedure to withdraw from **NHI**.
You may submit your withdrawal application using one of the following methods:
 - ・ Online (electronic application)
 - ・ By mail
 - ・ In person at the division in charge※To apply online, please scan the QR code shown on the right.
※This notice has been sent to individuals who were enrolled in NHI as of **June 18, 2026**.
- ③ Please ensure that your NHI tax is paid by the due date.
If your NHI tax remains unpaid without a valid reason, you may be required, after prior notice, to pay the full cost of medical treatment at the time of service. If you are experiencing difficulty making payments, please contact the **Debt Collection Division** [*Saiken Kanri-ka*] in advance to discuss your situation and available payment arrangements.

For individuals who will turn 75 by **July 31, 2027**, and for foreign nationals, the expiration date shown on the Eligibility Certificate may differ from the date indicated above.

【Consider using a Myna Health Insurance Card】

To register and use your Myna Health Insurance Card, please follow the steps outlined below.

STEP 1. Apply for a My Number Card

■ Application methods

- ① Online (using a computer or smartphone)
- ② At a post office
- ③ At a nearby ID photo booth that supports My Number Card applications



STEP 2. Register your My Number Card as a Health Insurance Card

■ Registration methods

- ① At a medical institution or pharmacy using a facial recognition card reader terminal
- ② Through the MynaPortal website or app
- ③ At a Seven Bank ATM
